

# FREE NALOXONE TRAINING



This voluntary event is being offered to all Indiana Clinical and Translational Sciences Institute faculty and staff.



Often referred to by its brand name, Narcan, naloxone is a drug used to treat opioid overdose. Naloxone reverses the effects of opioids making it a key factor in saving the life of someone who has overdosed.



The Naloxone training will be offered twice on **Thursday, April 25** from either 11-noon or 2-3pm in room 1110 of the Health Information and Translational Sciences building (HITS).
