### **Applicant:**

Upload to WebCAMP as separate PDF files-

1. Completed Application Intake Form with Institutional Signature Block completed on page 4
2. Completed Application Form (5 pages maximum for description of research)
3. Bibliography or citation list (does not count towards 5-page application limit)
4. Applicant's Curriculum Vitae (5 pages maximum)
5. Transcript from current graduate program (unofficial transcripts are accepted)
6. NIH non-fellowship Biosketch for the Primary Mentor
7. NIH non-fellowship Biosketch for the Co-Mentor

*The Primary Mentor and the Co-Mentor email Letters of Support for the applicant directly to Patty McGuire, [pcmccguir@iu.edu](mailto:pcmccguir@iu.edu); Two letters of support - one from the clinician or clinician-scientist mentor with a doctoral degree and one from the non-clinician (i.e., basic, life, or engineering) scientist mentor with a doctoral degree.*

### **Primary Mentor** provides:

1. Current NIH Biosketch with the intent to indicate research publications and grant support; email Biosketch to the applicant to upload to WebCAMP with their application.
2. Letter of Support for applicant emailed to [pcmccguir@iu.edu](mailto:pcmccguir@iu.edu). The letter should include a brief statement regarding how the trainee's proposed research will complement your research program. Also, an evaluation of the strengths and weakness of the candidate's preparation for conducting clinical translational science is required along with a description of training activities that will be completed to address any weaknesses.

### **Co-Mentor** provides:

1. Current NIH Biosketch with the intent to indicate research publications and grant support; email Biosketch to the applicant to upload to WebCAMP with their application.
2. Letter of Support for applicant emailed to [pcmccguir@iu.edu](mailto:pcmccguir@iu.edu). The letter should include a brief statement regarding how the trainee's proposed research will complement your research program. Also, an evaluation of the strengths and weakness of the candidate's preparation for conducting clinical translational science is required along with a description of training activities that will be completed to address any weaknesses.
